Gokov Rajapmohammed – a student of the Faculty of foreign languages shares his opinion about studying in Belarus and why he chose Mogilev State A.Kuleshov University.



I am Gokov Rajapmohammed. Four years ago I came to Belarus to get higher education. Now I'd tell you how it was, and why I chose Mogilev State A.Kuleshov University.

I was born in the city of Ashgabat. I studied in the secondary school No42 in the Russian department, in the music class. Later I learned that one of my friends is also going to enter Mogilev State A.Kuleshov University, the Faculty of

Foreign Languages, where students can learn not only English, but also a second foreign language. Then I found out some information about the university, students praised it highly and at the same time they said that training there is not so easy, as it requires diligent effort to obtain good knowledge, but I was not scared. because without knowledge vou can't achieve anything.

I remember that it was hard to leave my native home. My parents knew that the climate is

Later I found a lot of friends, and what is more important to me, I discovered a new talent. I



should say thanks to my teachers. I became interested in literature as well, and now I am writing poems and songs and as I learned music in school, I can compose it by myself.

I have a younger brother who likes the German language, he will finish school soon and how do you think, where he is going to apply? Of course, Mogilev State A.Kuleshov University.
