Brief content of the academic discipline:

The structure of the discipline "Fundamentals of psychology" is systemic and includes five interrelated sections of consideration of psychology issues. The first section - Introduction to psychology - is devoted to the consideration of the subject and methods of psychology as a science, consciousness and human activity. The second section - Cognitive sphere of personality - is a consideration of the psychological foundations of attention, sensations and perception, memory, imagination, thinking, speech. The third section - Emotional-volitional sphere of personality - is devoted directly to the study of emotions, feelings and will. The fourth section - Social psychology of personality - includes consideration of issues related to personality and its socialization, orientation and self-awareness of personality, personality and communication. The fifth section - Individual psychological characteristics of personality - is a consideration of the psychological foundations of temperament, character and abilities.
