Brief content of the academic discipline:

The structure of the discipline "Social psychology" has a systemic character and is represented by the following sections: "Introduction to social psychology", "Social psychology of personality", "Interpersonal communication and interpersonal relations", "Group psychology", "Social behaviour". The first section provides an introduction to the subject, purpose, objectives and methods of social psychology and the main stages of its development as a science. The second section includes a consideration of the problem of the individual in the social world; the relationship of behaviour to the motivation and social attitudes of the individual. The third section deals with various aspects of interpersonal communication and interpersonal relations; introduction to the concept of conflict, its structure, dynamics and strategies of personality behaviour in a conflict situation. The fourth section deals with the socio-psychological features of a social group, group phenomena and processes, as well as the patterns of personality behaviour in a group. The fifth section provides an introduction to different types of social behaviour of the individual.
