Summary of the content of the academic discipline:	
<p>The academic discipline studies the situation of Christian confessions-orthodoxy, Old Believers, Roman Catholicism, Protestantism in the Belarusian territories of the Russian Empire of the late XVIII – early XX centuries: the relationship of state authorities with Orthodox and non-Orthodox clergy and the population; legislative regulation of the activities of Christian confessions; strengthening the position of the Orthodox Church; loyal attitude to the Old Believers, limiting the activities of the Roman Catholic Church; curbing the potential of Protestantism; changes in the position and activities of Christian denominations in the early XX century in connection with changes in the legislation of the Russian Empire in 1905 and 1917 .</p>
