**Brief content of the academic discipline:**

The survey topics touch on issues related to the era general characteristics, cultural and literary development of a certain time; more attention is paid to writers whose work is not studied monographically. The monographic topics cover the life and creative work of writers. The discipline “Belarusian children’s literature” provides for a detailed study of works for secondary school and wide use of the possibilities of literature as the art of the word in the process of students’ professional training.
