<p>The academic discipline studies the fundamental points in the history of Belarus: sources and historiography of the history of Belarus, human reclamation of the Belarusian lands in antiquity, disintegration of the primitive communal system, the formation of statehood on the territory of Belarus, the development of Belarusian lands as part of the Old Russian state (IX – first half of the XIII centuries), the Grand Duchy of Lithuania (second half of the XIII – first half of the XVI cent.), the Polish–Lithuanian Commonwealth (second half of the XVI – late XVIII cent.), the Russian Empire (late XVIII – early XX cent.), the USSR (1922 – 1991), the situation of the Republic of Belarus at the end of the XX – first third of the XXI century.</p>
