Brief content of the academic discipline:	
<p>The academic discipline “Introduction to linguistics” is included in the university component module “Fundamentals of linguistics”. The content structure of the discipline educational material is based on the thematic approach, which provides for the division of educational material into relatively independent sections (topics). For each academic topic, in accordance with its goals and objectives for the formation and development of students’ specific competencies, the teacher (department) designs and implements specific pedagogical techniques.</p>
