<p>"Introduction to Slavic Philology" is a propaedeutic course that creates the basis for the study of the disciplines of the historical-linguistic and historical-literary cycle by students of the first stage of higher education. The discipline introduces students to Slavic philology as part of Slavic studies, with the concept of kinship of Slavic languages, aims to study modern and ancient Slavic languages and literatures in connection with the history of Slavic peoples. The course introduces the system of concepts and terms used by any linguistic discipline; gives an idea of the material and spiritual life of the Slavs in ancient times; examines various hypotheses of localization of the ancestral homeland of the Slavs, their languages and literatures.</p>
