<b>Competencies to be formed</b>	To characterize the main stages of the development of Russian literature in the aspect of generic and species belonging of artistic works, the peculiarities of their poetic and stylistic organization. To take into account in the analysis of literary works methodological foundations of Russian literary and critical thought, the conditions of its formation and development.
<b>Brief content of the academic discipline:</b> <p>The discipline "History of Russian literature of the first half of the 19th century" is part of the module of the state component "History of Russian literature and literary criticism". Educational material is structured in accordance with the principle of systematic and conceptual study of Russian literature, revealing the main trends and characteristics of the development of the literary process. The structure of the discipline reflects the relationship of the literary process with the socio-historical development of the society, takes into account the immanent regularities in the development of literature, the nature of the relationship with the national literary tradition and world literature. The study of general trends in the development of Russian literature in the first half of the 19th century is combined with the monographic study of works and creative individuality of the most significant writers. Particular attention is paid to the historiography of Russian literature of this period, theoretical problems and modern interpretation of literary classics.</p>
