The module “Academic Reading” is aimed at the development of the skills of reading and analysing authentic texts of various genres. The module “Practical Grammar” is devoted to the study of 6 grammatical topics. The first topic is “The Sequence of Tenses. Direct and Reported Speech”. The second topic is “The Noun”.
