The academic discipline studies the fundamental moments of the history of Belarus: the sources and historiography of the history of Belarus, human development of the territory of the Belarusian lands in antiquity, the decomposition of the primitive communal system, the formation of statehood on the territory of Belarus, the development of the Belarusian lands as part of the Old Russian state (IX - first half of the XIII centuries), the Grand Duchy of Lithuania (the second half of the XIII - the first half of the XVI centuries), the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth (the second half of the XVI - the end of the XVIII centuries), the Russian Empire (the end of the XVIII - the beginning of the XX centuries), the USSR (1922 - 1991), the position of the Republic of Belarus at the end of the XX – the first third of the XXI.
