Summary of the content of the academic discipline:	
<p>«Sampling method in sociology» is an academic discipline that teaches students the theoretical and practical fundamentals of constructing a sample population of empirical research, and calculating the optimal size of a given sample. The content of the discipline includes work in the following areas: defining of the concept and role of the sampling method in empirical sociology; consideration of statistical and non-statistical approaches to the formation of a sample set; study of the main methods of constructing sampling sets; teaching of the calculation of the sample set's size; consideration of variants of justification the representativeness of sociological research data obtained with different approaches to formation of sampling; determination of the most optimal model of the sample set, taking into account the peculiarities of the object, the available data, and also the purpose of the research tasks.</p>
