Brief content of the academic discipline:

«Academic writing» is an academic discipline that aims to develop the skills of critical reading, critical writing, structuring and formatting of academic texts. The academic discipline introduces the specifics procedural design in the process of scientific communication and genres of academic texts; forms the skills of searching and mastering various types of sources; teaches abstracting, summarizing and reviewing academic texts. It allows to form the critical evaluation of argumentation skills; introduces the criteria for evaluating academic texts; forms the skills of writing academic texts, as well as competent design and presenting the academic texts of various genres; teaches strategies for searching and selecting bibliographic sources, assessing the reliability and relevance of sources.
