Brief summary of the academic discipline:	

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Within the framework of educational psychology, the problems of managing the process of assimilation of knowledge, psychological laws of learning, psychological factors influencing its success are studied, and psychological aspects of pedagogical activity are also considered. The problems of educational psychology considered within the framework of the academic discipline are analyzed from the standpoint of the personal-activity approach in the general context of the main trends in the development of modern education. In accordance with this

approach, the content of the discipline pays special attention to the problems that today form the foundation of educational psychology. Such key problems are: interaction between a teacher and students as educational cooperation of equal partners, psychological characteristics of a teacher and students as subjects of educational activity, psychological patterns of teaching and education, as well as psychological features of educational activity.

The current level of development of psychological science and psychological and pedagogical practice shows that an effective process of teaching and education is impossible without the participation of qualified psychologists who have knowledge, skills, and abilities in the field of educational psychology.
