Economics (economy) is a natural property of any subject of social relations. The economy (farm), as a property of the subject of public relations, is both a producer of material and non-material goods that ensure the functioning of the state, society and the individual, and a mechanism for ensuring social and political stability, as well as the economic well-being of the social organism. Economics (economy) as a property of the state as a whole (macroeconomics) is the basis of the functioning of the state and the basis of national security. Accordingly, the functioning of the economy (farm) is a process of production of tangible and intangible, expressed in the implementation of public and private economic activities carried out both in the mode of entrepreneurial and non-entrepreneurial economic activity.
