Brief content of the academic discipline:

«Judiciary» is an academic discipline, the subject of which is a knowledge system about law enforcement, the judiciary, justice, the court organization and law enforcement agencies in the Republic of Belarus and some foreign countries.

This course introduces future lawyers to the concepts of law enforcement, judicial power, justice, the judiciary, judicial units and instances, prosecutorial supervision, tasks, organization, powers, as well as the main stages in the development of the court and law enforcement agencies (the prosecutor's office, preliminary investigation bodies, bodies justice, advocacy and notaries).
