Brief content of the academic discipline:

The academic discipline studies the fundamental moments of the history of Belarus: sources and historiography of the history of Belarus, human development of the territory of the Belarusian lands in antiquity, the decomposition of the primitive communal system, the formation of statehood on the territory of Belarus, the development of Belarusian lands as part of the old Russian state (IX – first half of the XIII centuries), the Grand Duchy of Lithuania (second half of the XIII – first half of the XVI centuries), the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth (second half of the XVI – end of the XVIII centuries), the Russian Empire (end of the XVIII – beginning of the XX centuries), the USSR (1922 – 1991), the situation of the Republic of Belarus at the end of the XX – first third of the XXI century.
