## Brief content of the academic discipline:

The academic discipline studies the fundamental moments of the Belarusian history: sources and historiography of the history of Belarus, the development of the territory of the Belarusian lands by man in antiquity, the disintegrataion of the primitive-communal system, the formation of statehood on the territory of Belarus, the development of Belarusian lands as part of the Old Russian state (IX – first half of the XIII centuries), the Grand Duchy of Lithuania (second half of the XIII century – first half of the XVI centuries), the Polish –Lithuanian Commonwealth (second half of the XVI century – the end of the XVIII century), the Russian Empire (late XVIII century – early XX centuries), the USSR (1922 – 1991), in the position of the Republic of Belarus at the end of the XX century – first third of the XXI.
