Brief content of the academic discipline:

The structure of the Foreign Language course includes two consecutive modules. The first one - the social communication module - allows deepening and systematisation of the learners' grammar, lexical, communicative skills and communicative models corresponding to various everyday situations. The second part of the course - the professional communication module - addresses professional communication situations, professional and specialised vocabulary and its specific application, and provides the necessary skills for abstracting topical texts.
